Some Clarification on Collection of Garbage, Recycling, Big Items & Cardboard

<u>RECYCLING - WEDNESDAY</u>	<u>COMPOST - WEDNESDAY</u>	<u>LARGE ITEMS & CARDBOARD</u>
<p>Plastic Bags are no longer accepted Paper products, glass, cans and plastics should be cleaned and placed together in a blue box.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Newspapers, flyers and magazines • Cardboard, bundled (1m x 1m x 1/2m thick) with jute or twine • Plastics • Rinsed flower pots and trays • Empty, dry metal paint cans • Glass bottles and metal cans • Fast food coffee cups and lids • Tetra pak boxes • Milk and juice cartons • Aluminum plates and trays <p>SHREDDED PAPER IS THE ONLY MATERIAL THAT CAN BE PLACED IN A CLEAR TRANSPARENT BAG!</p>	<p>Plastic Bags are no longer accepted. ONLY PAPER BAGS! (NO FOOD PRODUCTS)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compostables (leaves, grass, garden waste) must be in paper bags or open containers (no lid) marked on two sides with an "X". • Brush must be in paper bags or open containers marked on two sides with an "X" or be bundled with a compostable material (jute or twine) and be no longer than 4 feet long. Brush in plastic bags will not be collected. • Brush includes branches regardless of diameter, twigs, hedges, shrubs, vines and rose bushes. • NO tree trunks or logs. 	<p>CARDBOARD There is a large container in the office/shop yard for cardboard. Please break up your cardboard flat and put in bin.</p> <p>LARGE ITEMS Please call the office to have your large items disposed of. We will accept the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Furniture, Stoves, Barbecues - no propane tanks • Mattresses • Carpet must be rolled and tied, no wider than 4 feet • Refrigerators and freezers must be purged of freon and tagged by a refrigeration company • No junk items in boxes
<u>RESIDENTIAL WASTE - FRIDAY</u>	<u>NO AUTO-CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS</u>	<u>HAZARDOUS WASTE</u>
<p>Garbage will be picked up on Friday any colour of garbage bags or in a garbage pail only.</p>	<p>Toilets, sinks, vanities, windows, drywall, lumber, ceramic tiles, broken concrete, asphalt, auto parts, doors, lawn mowers, etc. will not be disposed of by the office.</p>	<p>On the last day of each month you can bring your hazardous waste to the shop yard for removal NO ELECTRONICS</p>
