The lucky 7 Bingo Bonus has not been won so is now worth \$329.00

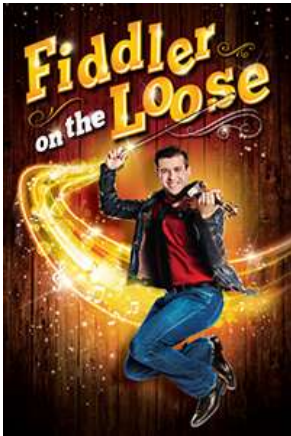
